Meeting of the Deputy Prime Minister Ademi and the Slovak Minister of foreign Affairs Lajchak



Deputy Prime Minister of the Government in charge of European Affairs, Arbr Ademi PhD, had a meeting with the Minister of Foreign and European Affairs, Mr. Miroslav Lajcak, in his capacity as chairman of the EU Council.

Deputy Prime Minister Ademi congratulated the EU presidency by Slovakia to his colleague and wished him successful implementation of his goals and priorities. During the meeting they also discussed the bilateral cooperation between the two countries and the current political situation in the country.

During the conversation, Deputy Prime Minister Ademi pointed out that since the takeover of the EU presidency is happening at a time of serious challenges that will require great commitment and focus by the European institutions and Member States, and he also mentioned Brexit, the events in Turkey, the recent terrorist attacks in Nice, France and the prolonged migrant crisis, it should not be reflected in the slowdown of the enlargement process and the integration of the Western Balkans countries.

Deputy Prime Minister Ademi participated on the informal meeting of Ministers for European Affairs in Bratislava



Deputy Prime Minister Ademi attended the informal meeting of Ministers for European Affairs, at the invitation of the Slovak presidency, organised within the General Affairs Council of the European Union, held in Bratislava on 24. and 25. July 2016. The EU Enlargement Commissioner Johannes Hahn and all ministers for European affairs and their representatives from the candidate countries of the Western Balkans and Turkey attended the meeting.

The chairman on behalf of the Slovak presidency, Ivan Korczak stated that enlargement remains in the focus of the European Union. Commissioner Hahn noted that in recent weeks there is serious progress in the process in almost all countries of the region. For Macedonia, Commissioner Hahn emphasised that the good news on the political agreement now need to materialise through the full implementation of what was agreed, without delay.

At the beginning of his address, Deputy Prime Minister Ademi thanked for the invitation to this informal meeting, which is one more confirmation of the commitment and support to the process of EU integration. He referred to the serious challenges the European Union is facing at the time of assuming the presidency by Slovakia, such as Brexit, the events in Turkey, the terrorist and security threats and the possibility of escalation of the migrant crisis. Also, he noted that they would require a huge commitment and focus by the EU institutions and in those circumstances, he expressed hope that it will contribute to the consolidation of the EU policies by undertaking measures to prevent risks in the future and continuing successful policies, especially the decades of proven successful enlargement policy. Deputy Prime Minister Ademi stressed that we should not forget the enlargement policy, which can and should be part of the solution to these challenges.
